


Top Online Media Outlets in




Methodology

This ranking is derived from a structured analysis of Facebook engagement among major and emerging media outlets in Sierra Leone, using data collected through the Facebook API for all posts published between 14–20 December, 2025. For each outlet, we captured core interaction metrics (likes, comments, and shares) and cleaned and standardized the dataset to ensure accuracy and comparability.

Engagement was summarized using a Net Engagement Score (NES), calculated as the sum of the average (per-post normalized) likes, comments, and shares for each outlet, ensuring that outlets posting more frequently did not receive an unfair advantage. The final ranking reflects each institution's overall engagement intensity during the analysis period, offering a consistent, data-driven comparison of audience interaction across the media landscape. Results will be published weekly.
